Site description:

This site is a 1 hectare fenced area of river flat that has been milled and most of the Totara (*Podocarpus totara*) taken out. The understory is mostly rank exotic grasses with patches of tree nettle (*Urtica ferox*) and regenerating shrubby coprosmas. There are emergent Kahikitea (*Dacrycarpus dacrydioides*), Matai (*Prumnopitys taxifolia*), Totara and Tawa (*Beilschmiedia tawa*) with a subcanopy of mainly Titoki (*Alectryon excelsus*). Scattered amongst the nettle and shrubs are a small number of ferns and herbs. *Fuchsia perscandens* was noted in a couple of places

The recent drought wiped out a lot of the fern population (owner pers. comm.). There are one or two plants of *Dicksonia fibrosa* left but several juvenile tree ferns are evidence of slow regeneration.

Survey thorough.
