## Indigenous Vascular Plants at Dalgleish Bush

Site description:

This 6 hectare patch of bush sits in a limestone basin 400 m above the Wairarapa plains in the Maungaraki range. It is bounded on the east and south a boggy area that drains the basin. There is a fairly steep bank, getting higher to the north, up onto a gently sloping area. There are definite ecological preferences shown by the vegetative cover. Rewarewa (Knightia excelsa) is the dominant emergent tree especially to the north and west with some large maires (Nestegis cunninghamii in the main) also present. There appears to have been some logging of the podocarps and what remain are some smaller kahikatea (Dacrycarpus dacrydioides) and a lone matai (Prumnopitys taxifolia). There is a large small leaved maire (Nestegis montana) just outside the fence to the north. The shrub boundary is mainly Coprosma rotundifolia with one plant carrying the most notable item in the area. This was the locally rare mistletoe Ileostylus micranthus a small plant of which was seen on the southern boundary.

The area is fenced but grazed and consequently the herbaceous and fern flora is very depleted with Hypolepis ambigua the only fern that seems to be generally unpalatable and hence is quite common. There was one small tree fern (Dicksonia squarrosa) and odd plants of other species growing under patches of tree nettle (Urtica ferox) which was quite common around the bush margins.

There was what would have once been a swamp, just south of the bush area but this has been drained and what remains is a stand of Carex secta on quite large pedestals and the only plants of Myrsine australis that were seen.

There are several seepages up the valley to the southeast one of which contained Epilobium chionanthum, a species that has not been listed from the Eastern Wairarapa before.
