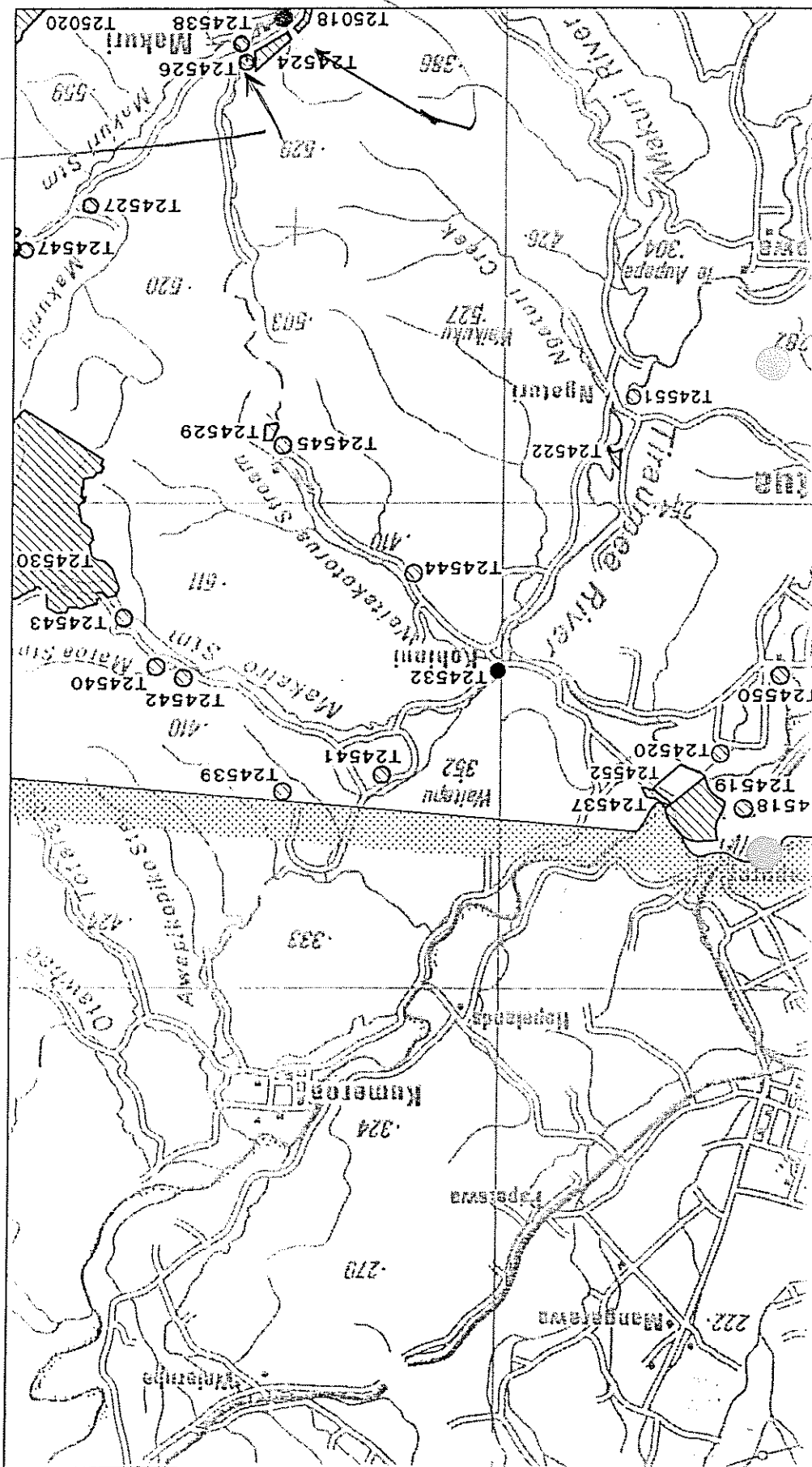

Site description: This is a small, heavily grazed remnant on the banks of the Makuri River. Podocarps are generally second growth, having arisen after earlier disturbance, however there are some sizeable totara trees among them, at least one large enough to have been in the primary forest.

The canopy and larger trees and shrubs appear in good health.

Grazing over a number of years has reduced the understorey to exotic grasses and weeds, though in one part there is a kind of "totara forest" establishing with thick growth of tree nettle as an understorey. Elsewhere there is little evidence of leaf litter accumulation.

Many of the plants are draped in the rata vine *Metrosideros colensoi*, adding to the visual appeal of the site.

Most of the larger trees also contained a large number of epiphytic species.

The lack ferns, grasses, sedges and forest floor species reflects the grazing history of the site, however, the close proximity of the Makuri Gorge Scenic Reserve and the smaller Makuri Township Scenic Reserve means that a substantial seed source is close at hand if stock can be excluded from the site.

Apart from the grazing induced herbaceous species, weeds are not a major factor here. Some sycamores are present, along with willow, but these are not of problem proportions. A single plant of old man's beard was seen and removed. The small size (< 5ha) of this remnant is such that a good appreciation could be gained in a short time.
