NOTES

"High Ridge" Covenant is part of Bob and Jan Stott's 100 acre property which was depicted on a map produced by the New Zealand Company in January 1843, together with other similar sized blocks in the valley.

The 6.7ha covenant was registered on the title of the property in 1998.

Soil: Makara hill soil.

Substrate: Greywacke sandstone

Landform: Both sides of a gully, the stream being a tributary of Horokiri Stream which flows into Pauatahanui Inlet.

Aspect: True Left side of valley faces south; True Right side faces north.

Rainfall: ca. 1130mm average over 9 years.

Fencing: Completed in 1997.

Pest control: Bait stations are installed. Brodifacoum anticoagulant kills possums, and rodents are killed by eating the spilt baits. Goats are shot.
