### **NOTES**

The site is a well-drained alluvial terrace and riser.

- # Kohekohe to 25m+, titoki to 16m+, senescent ngaio to 18m, tawa to 20m+; no mature nikau, but numerous saplings;
- # Most tiers between kawakawa at 1 - 2 m and the canopy are missing, except for occasional *Coprosma areolata*;
- # Scant groundcover in places, but vigorous kohekohe and karaka seedling growth elsewhere;
- # Insect browse common on titoki;
- # No kohekohe fruit seen;
- # Illegal dumping of rubbish, especially at the Ngaio Road end;
- # Track through remnant links Iti Grove and Ngaio Road;
- # Bait stations seen near Ngaio Road end and on upper terrace;
- # Boundaries should be extended to include entire remnant.
