Indigenous Vascular Plants at Waimana Bush

Site description

This site comprises three areas of bush, two of them are fenced off and the other is grazed and has little understory or regeneration. The one of the fenced areas and the grazed area are now under different ownership from the other fenced area. The fenced area behind the old house site (Area 1) and nearest the swimming pool and the tennis courts is a small hill and the other fenced area (Area2) and the grazed area (Area2) are contiguous on the next hilltop. They are separated by a grassy avenue that leads down to the stockyards.

Area 2 has had a number of pines felled near the top centre of the patch and this has opened up the area and subsequently caused a number of older trees to be exposed and felled by the wind. The resultant tangle is full of fallen trees, nettle (Urtica ferox) and poroporo (Solanum laciniatum) and almost impossible to progress through. There were a number of species that were only found in this area and they are indicated on the list by an @ sign.

The grazed area was surveyed by a quick walk around and by scanning with binoculars. Apart from kowhai (Sophora microphylla) nothing unique to this area was noted.

Area 1 was surveyed as thoroughly as possible and a number of interesting species were noted. There were a number of emergent species with some large rimu (Dacrydium cupressinum) matai (Prumnopitys taxifolia) totara (Podocarpus totara) rewarewa (Knightia excelsa) miro (Prumnopitys ferruginea) hinau (Elaeocarpus dentatus) and both black and white maire (Nestegis cunninghamii and N. lanceolata). The shrub understory was mainly Coprosma grandiflora with a scattering of other tree and shrub species. The whole area was once surrounded by yew (Taxus baccata) (foliage very like miro) and another exotic conifer, but these have been removed in the main from the western side allowing a shrubby tangle to develop and close off the forest from the wind. It is here that Brachyglottis sciadophila was found. This is a species with a national ranking of "local" and with only one other site known in the Wellington conservancy at present. There has been some replanting along this margin and this may pose a threat as these trees mature and possibly crowd out the brachyglottis.

Single plants of silver fern (Cyathea dealbata), gully fern (Cyathea cunninghamii) and several plants of Dicksonia squarrosa and Cyathea smithii represented tree ferns.

Although the area is fenced browsing was noted on the hook sedges (Uncinia scabra and U. laxiflora) but this may be attributably to rabbits, which were noted in the area.

The main weed problem is with spindle tree (Euonymus europaeus) and the shelterbelts seeding into the main bush area. Jeruselem cherry (Solanum niger) is also growing in the clearings and around the margins.

Area 2 had much the same species distribution with fewer big trees and more tree ferns (C. dealbata). The southern margin did have a number of species that were not found elsewhere. Fuchsia excorticata and the liana F. perscandens along with Coprosma robusta, C. rigida, bidibidi (Acaena anserinifolia), Juncus gregiflorus and water bracken (Histiopteris incisa) were found here.

Both areas have been fenced for some time and it would be good to have some formal protection afforded to them particularly for Area 1.
