Notes on Species

All native species recorded are typical, widespread species of Matemateaonga Ecological District. Several of the adventive species are uncommon in the whole Wanganui Region, eg. water figwort (*Scrophularia auriculata*) has been recorded only in northern half of Northland, near Opotiki, and Outram in Otago; *Carex vulpinoidea* is recorded from northern half of North Island, and in NW Nelson, Buller, Westland; upright hedge parsley (*Torilis japonica*) is recorded from "Scattered localities in N. Auckland, Taranaki, Gisborne and Wellington Provinces" and south of Kaikoura and N. Canterbury and one Dunedin record; balm of Gilead (*Cedronella canariensis*) as a cultivation escape is recorded as "mostly rare and local" in North and South Islands (common about Wellington).
